1. There is no fear in love. But *perfect love drives out fear*, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love.
– 1 JOHN 4:18

2. I sought the Lord, and he answered me; he *delivered me from all my fears*. Those who look to him are radiant; their faces are never covered with shame.
– PSALM 34:4,5

3. He brought me out into a spacious place; *he rescued me because he delighted in me*.
– PSALM 18:19

4. God is our *refuge* and *strength*, an *ever-present help* in trouble.
– PSALM 46:1

5. He says, "*Be still, and know that I am God*; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth."
– PSALM 46:10

6. We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we *take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ*.
– 2 CORINTHIANS 10:5

7. *God has united you with Christ Jesus*. For our benefit God made him to be wisdom itself. Christ made us right with God; he made us *pure* and *holy*, and he *freed* us from sin.
– 1 CORINTHIANS 1:30

8. This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a *new person*. The old life is gone; *a new life has begun!*
– 2 CORINTHIANS 5:17

9. Even before he made the world, *God loved us and chose us* in Christ to be holy and without fault in his eyes.
– EPHESIANS 1:4

10. He is so rich in kindness and grace that he *purchased our freedom* with the blood of his Son and forgave our sins.
– EPHESIANS 1:7

11. For *we are God's masterpiece*. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.
– EPHESIANS 2:10

12. Because of Christ and our faith in him, *we can now come boldly and confidently into God's presence.*
– EPHESIANS 3:12

13. *You didn't choose me. I chose you.* I appointed you to go and produce lasting fruit, so that the Father will give you whatever you ask for, using my name.
– JOHN 15:16

14. Yet *God freely and graciously declares that we are righteous.* He did this through Christ Jesus when he freed us from the penalty for our sins.
– ROMANS 3:24

15. No, despite all these things, *overwhelming victory is ours through Christ,* who loved us.
– ROMANS 8:37

16. No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, *nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God* that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.
– ROMANS 8:39

17. *Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you.* I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and *do not be afraid.*
